Article 1

With effect from

The **APPVA** will become member association of the Soldiers of Peace International Association (SPIA).

Article 2

The **APPVA** has to comply rigorously with SPIA statutes and rules.
It has also to respect rules set by the United Nations for NGOs in consultative status with ECOSOC.

Article 3

Activities of the **APPVA** should take place within its geographical scope, namely within the national territory.

Article 4

As for any international level activity, it must be conducted following the instructions of the SPIA International Association.

Article 5

The **APPVA** will respect all the rules pertaining to the use of SPIA logo in its current form, marked necessarily with the mention 'We believe'.

Article 6

The member Association will respect the acronym AISP (in French) or SPIA (in English): the two official languages of UN Peacekeeping missions. (cf 'Graphic Charter').

Article 7

APPVA will respect the established guidelines concerning page layout as well as writing conventions. (cf 'Graphic Charter').

Article 8

APPVA will participate to the General Assembly of SPIA and other international meetings following the principle of one country one vote.

General Assembly will decide by qualified majority vote.

Article 9

APPVA will respect and implement all decisions taken by the General Assembly or by the Executive Committee.

Article 10

Any breach of the above rules will lead to the exclusion of APPVA to be blamed for.

The exclusion has the following consequences: APPVA will lose its membership status, as well as the right to use the SPIA logo and acronym.

Above all, APPVA to be blamed will have to abandon all activities linked to SPIA.

Article 11

Signature of the present membership agreement has to be preceded by the signature of cooperation agreement: the membership status comes after that a satisfying cooperation basis with SPIA International has been found.

Status of membership will be granted only after ratification from the SPIA General Assembly.

Article 12

Signature of the present agreement will be published for advertising purposes in the respective countries.
