Am I eligible?

You may be eligible for benefits from DVA if you were a member of the AFP who has served in any of the following peacekeeping forces:

- **Cyprus** from 14 May 1964 and currently ongoing for service in the United Nations Force in Cyprus (UNFICYP)
- **Cambodia** from 18 May 1992 for service in the United Nations Transitional Authority in Cambodia (UNTAC)
- **Mozambique** from 27 March 1994 for service in the United Nations Operation in (UNOMOZ)
- **Haiti** from 10 October 1994 for service in the Multi-National Force
- **East Timor** from 11 June 1999 to 25 October 1999 for service in the United Nations Assistance Mission in East Timor (UNAMET)
- **East Timor** from 25 October 1999 to 19 May 2002 for service in the United Nations Transitional Administration in East Timor (UNTAET)
- **East Timor** from 20 May 2002 and is currently ongoing for service in the United Nations Mission in Support of East Timor (UNMISSET)
- **Solomon Islands** commencing on 24 July 2003 and is currently ongoing for service in the Regional Assistance Mission Solomon Islands (RAMSI)
- **Sudan** from 1 January 2006 and is currently ongoing for service in the United Nations Mission in Sudan (UNMIS).
