I strongly encourage delegates to stay for some extra days and perhaps tour the island state.

Defence have allowed us to use the Flexible Learning Centre at Anglesea, along with the messing arrangements.

However, changes in service delivery within Defence has meant that unlike previous years, we are

unable to utilise Defence accommodation.

There are a number of motels in the immediate vicinity of Anglesea - most around 200 - 300 metres away from the venue.

On page 2 of this E-Newsletter are the contact details of a number of premises. However, January and February are the peak of the tourist trade so delegate bookings will need to be made as soon as possible.

Should these venues be fully booked, other motels in Sandy Bay, Salamanca or Hobart area would be in suitable proximity to Anglesea.

will cover venue costs, refreshment facilities and lunch on both days.

If delegates can advise of their arrival flights, we will look at collection transport from Hobart Airport on Friday 5th.

As part of the National Conference, there will be the opportunity to view the site of the new memorial and there will be a guided tour of the Barracks provided by the Military Museum of Tasmania.
