

# CHAPLAIN TO THE VETERANS' COMMUNITY

## POSITION ADVERTISEMENT

The Creative Ministries Network (CMN) wishes to appoint a Chaplain to the Veterans' Community to develop our Veterans Faith and Wellbeing Support program. The Chaplain will support the program by addressing the trauma of war and peacekeeping service on veterans and their families through a ministry of spiritual care.
